## Swan Medical Group in partnership with Saving Lives Together

Swan Medical Group is pleased to announce a partnership with Saving Lives Together (SaLT), a community based CPR and defibrillator awareness charity headed up by their Nurse Supervisor Aisa Fraser, assisted by a team of dedicated local volunteers including Nurse Jackie Predeth.



The vision of the charity is to increase the likelihood of

survival rates of out of hospital cardiac arrest from around 7% at present in the UK to 36% and above as seen in the Netherlands. This can be achieved by teaching communities about the chain of survival, how to call for help, perform CPR, use defibrillators and that to act quickly can save someone's life. Spreading awareness of defibrillator location and use as well as practical CPR and defibrillator skills are key to this, and SaLT are training local businesses as well as community members on how to use the defibs stationed within the community.
