- Carers
- All pregnant women
- All children aged 2 or 3
- All patients aged 65 and over
- Any at risk children from 6 months old
- Patients with a BMI of 40 or more aged 18 years and over
- All patients of any age in a clinical risk group (these are underlying health conditions such as Heart, Kidney, Liver, Lung Disease, COPD, Diabetes, Compromised immune systems.

Spread the word... there's a new Defibrillator located at The Swan Surgery!

At the start of the year, Swan Medical Group began working in partnership with newly formed organisation Saving Lives Together whose movement provides free CPR and defibrillator awareness for the general public in an effort to improve outcomes following out of hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA). One of the reasons for our poor chances of survival can be directly attributed to low bystander CPR rates and lack of confidence using a defibrillator. Following some discussions within the surgery in Petersfield, we decided to install a cabinet so that a publicly accessible defibrillator be available for anyone even during the times when Swan Surgery is closed. This will be installed on 24th September 2018 and be placed on the wall outside the surgery between Boots midnight and the surgery. It will be registered with the ambulance service so that if in the event of an emergency, the call handler can direct members of the general public to it. We are thrilled to be able to offer this to the general public and while we hope that it does not have to be used, it is great that it is there should it be required and hopefully help save a life.
